In learning Six Hats your group will...

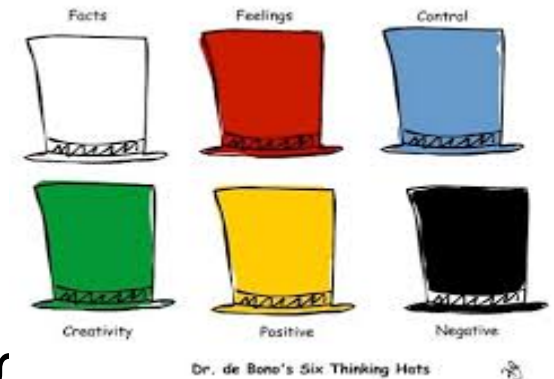
Know how to dig deeper

Get to the right solution quickly and with a shared vision

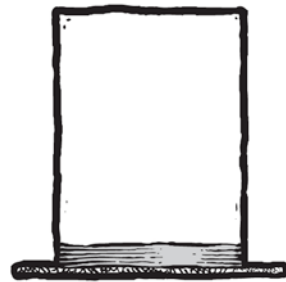

No conclusions. Just the facts.

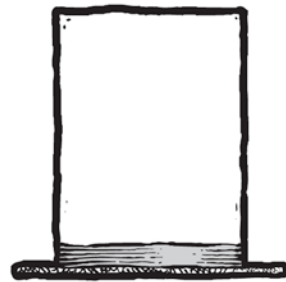
