- Circumcision w/o hypospadias, infant
- Dysuria
- Epidydimitis
- Erectile dysfunction
- Hydrocoele, infant, w/o hernia
- Infertility, male, initial workup
- Inguinal hernia
- Prostate cancer screening
- Prostatitis
- Undescended testicle, less than 1 year
- Urolithiasis, initial
- UTI, uncomplicated
- Varicocoele, left sided
