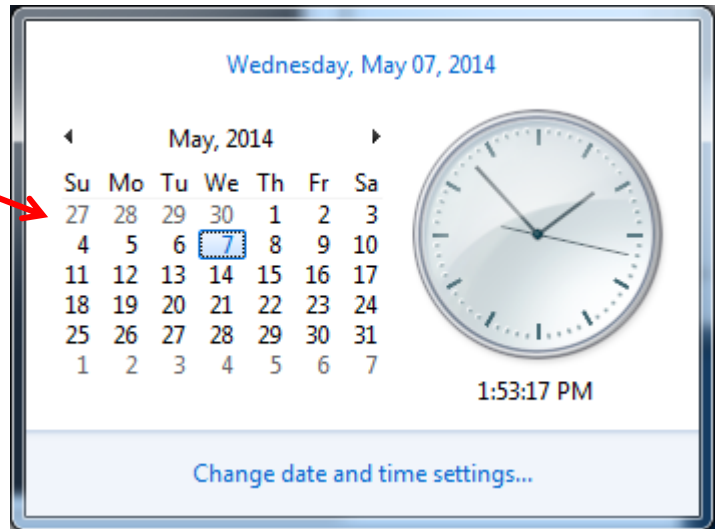


Adding Time Zones to Windows 7 Clock

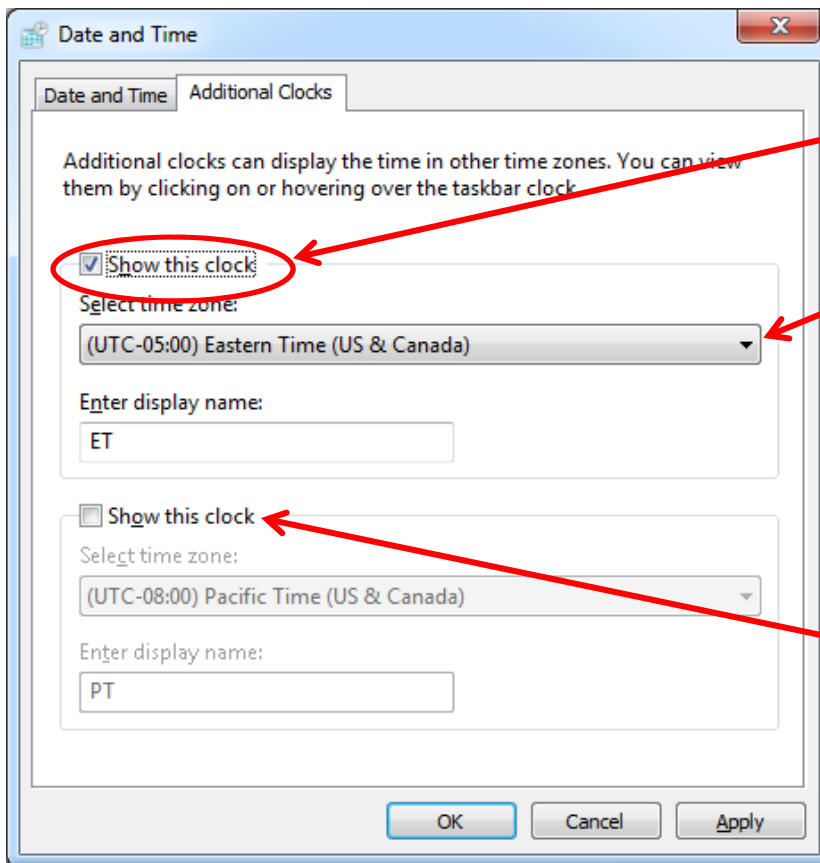
Do you need to keep up with time in different time zones around the world? Here is a way to add multiple times zones to the Windows 7 System Tray Clock.



Click on the date/time on the Task Bar



Click Change date and time settings...



To add a new time zone to your display, put a checkmark next to Show this clock

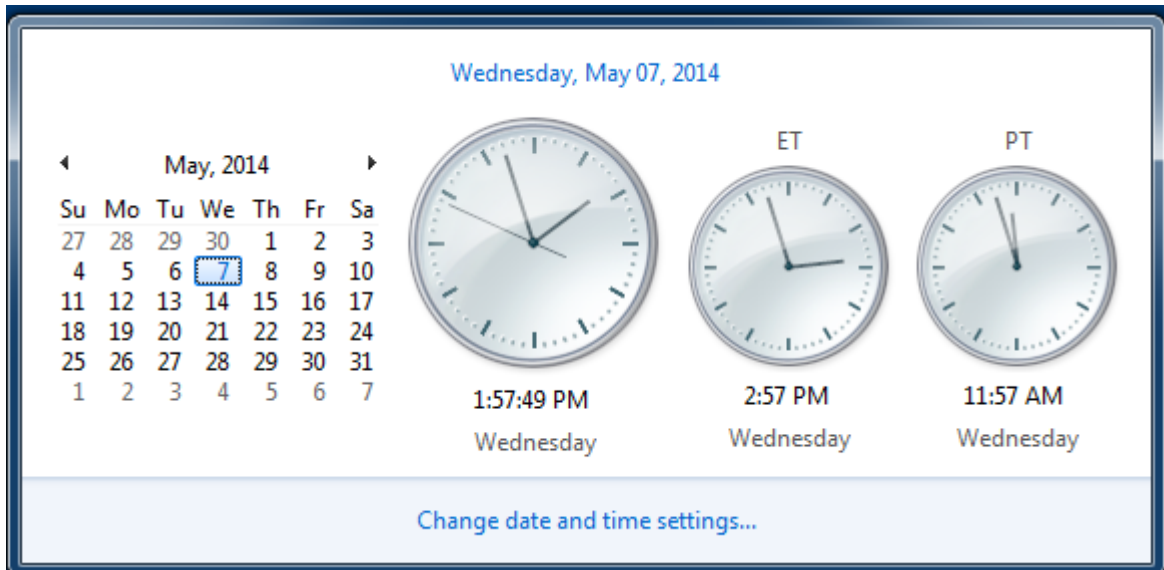
Then select a time zone from this drop-down list

Name your time zone something descriptive - I used ET to signify the Eastern Time Zone

You can have two additional time zones if you want - just check the second Show this clock and pick another time zone - again name it something descriptive

Click OK

Now when you click on the date/time on your taskbar, you can see up to three different time zones



In addition, if you just hover your mouse over the date/time on your taskbar, a quick pop-up will appear showing all of your time zones
