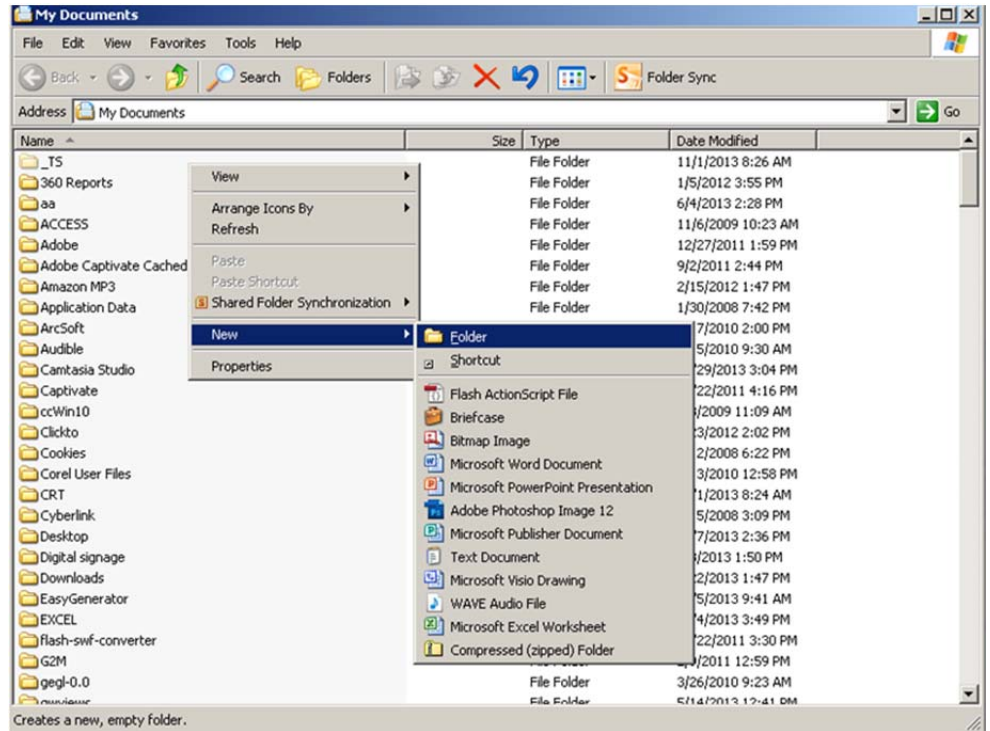


How to Export and Import Firefox Bookmarks

Let's start by creating a folder in your "My Documents" folder to save your bookmarks
(Your "My Documents" folder is your Home Folder, or your "H" Drive)

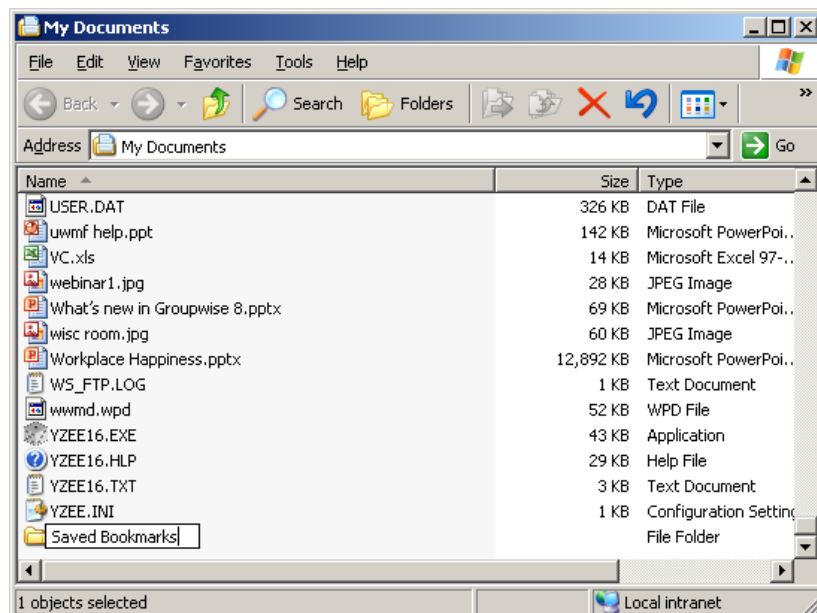
- Open your "My Documents" folder
- Right-click
- Select New
- Select Folder



Give your new folder a name - make it descriptive so it's easily recognizable by you in the future

Examples:

- Saved Bookmarks
- Bookmark backup

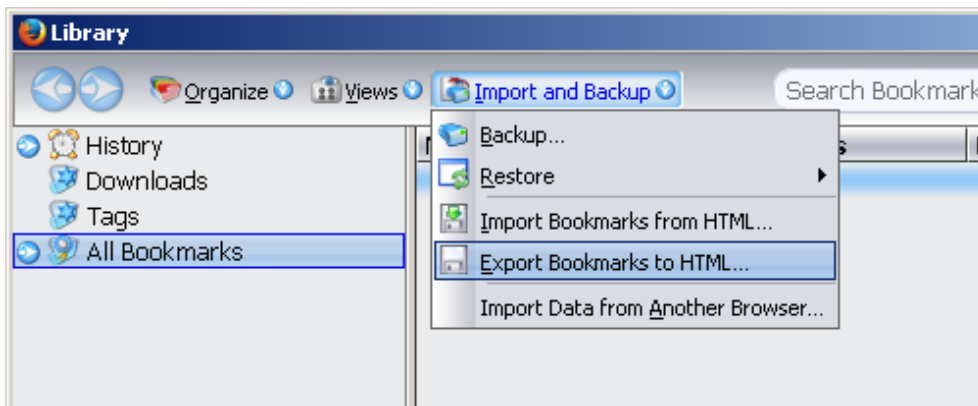
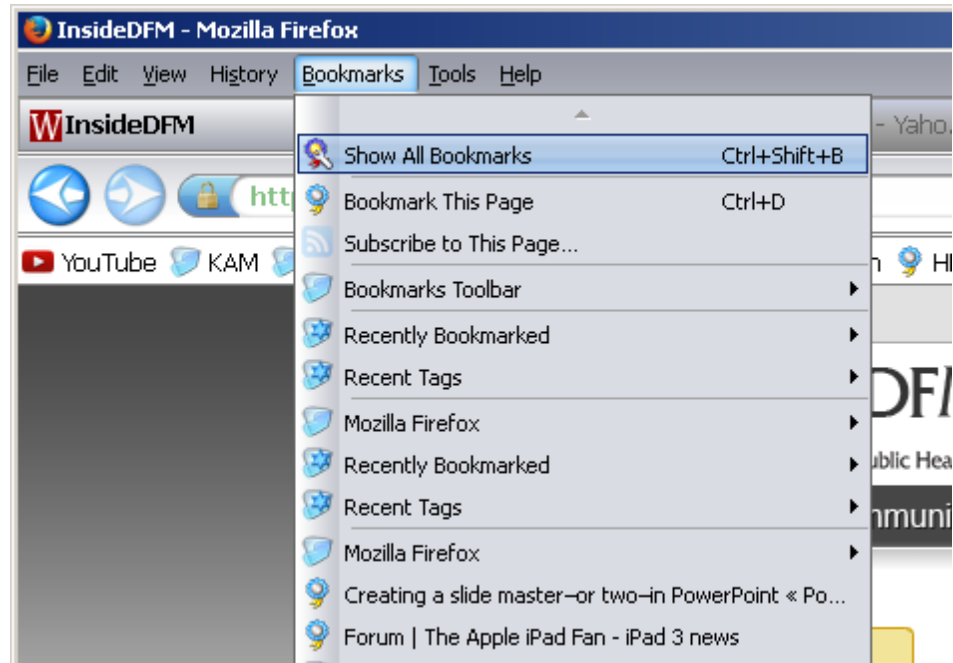


Exporting

To export and save your Firefox bookmarks, open Firefox

Click Bookmarks

Select "Show All Bookmarks"



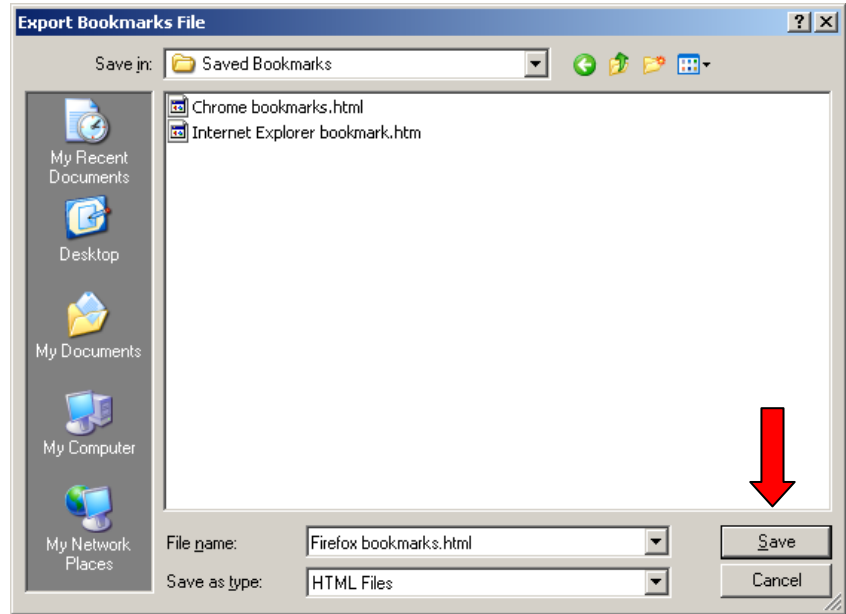
Select Import and Backup

Select Export Bookmarks to HTML

Choose your folder
- i.e., Saved Bookmarks

Name your file
- i.e., Firefox bookmarks.html

Click Save



Note:

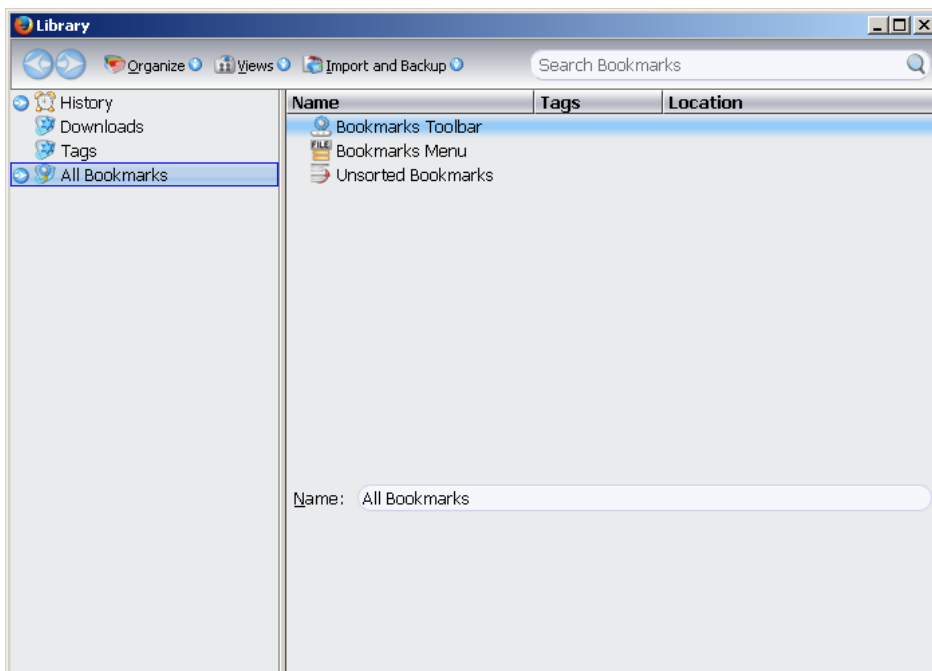
If you use more than one browser, save your bookmarks with an easily recognizable name.

For example:

Internet Explorer -- Internet Explorer bookmark.htm

Firefox -- Firefox bookmarks.html

Chrome -- Chrome bookmark.html

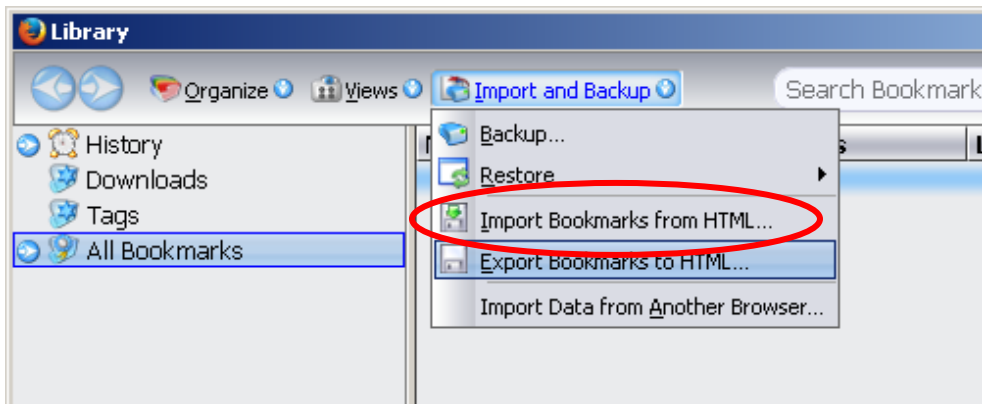
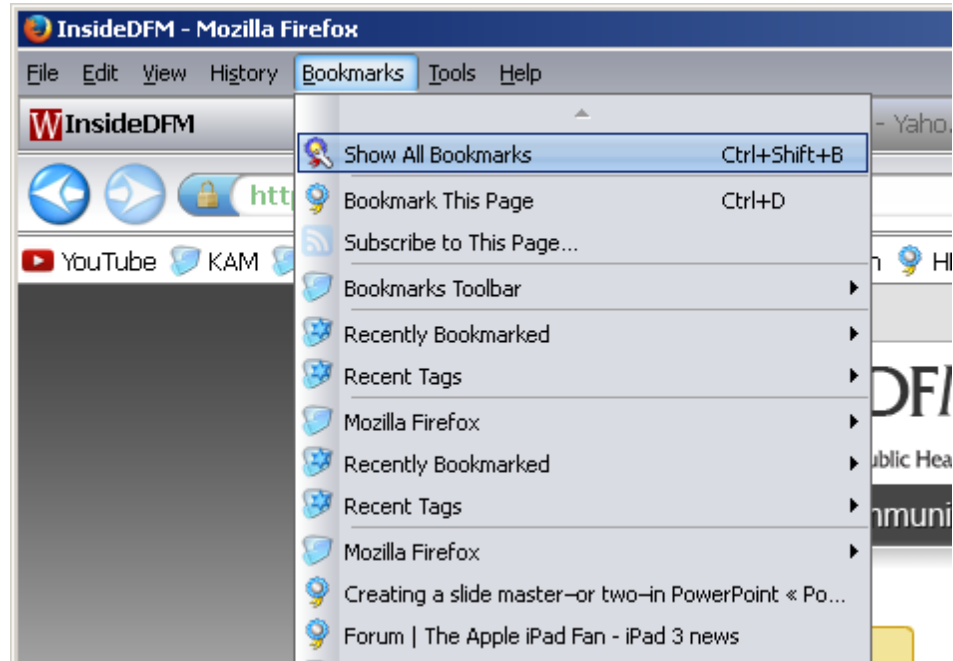


Close your

Importing

To import your saved Firefox bookmarks, open Firefox

Click Bookmarks
Select "Show All Bookmarks"



Select Import and Backup

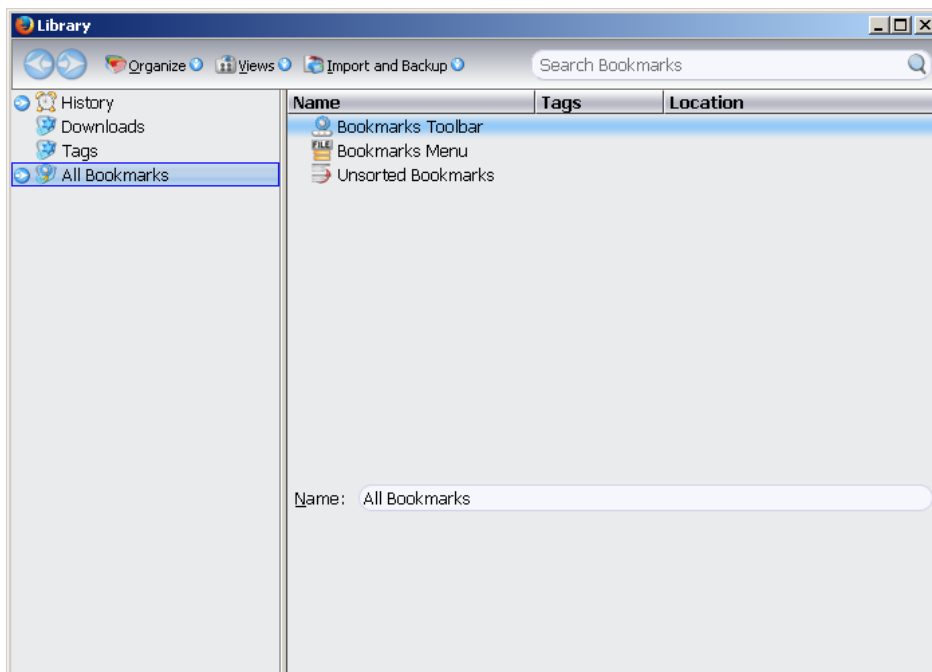
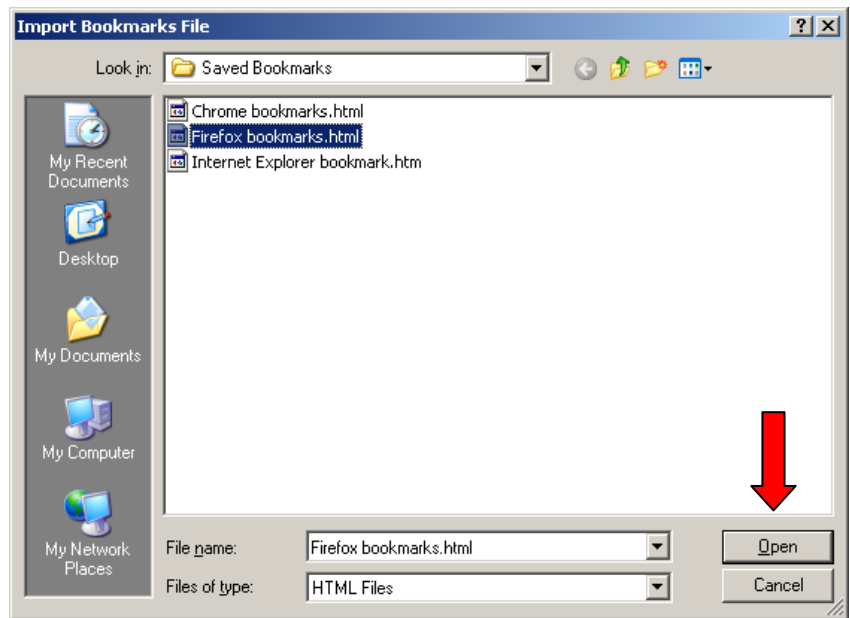
Select Import Bookmarks from HTML

Navigate to the folder where you saved your bookmark file

i.e., "Saved Bookmarks"

Find the appropriate bookmark file for Firefox

Click Open



Close your Bookmark Library
