
### How to Export and Import Internet Explorer Bookmarks

Let's start by creating a folder in your "My Documents" folder to save your bookmarks (Your "My Documents" folder is your Home Folder, or your "H" Drive)


- Open your "My Documents" folder
- Right-click
- Select New
- Select Folder



Give your new folder a name - make it descriptive so it's easily recognizable by you in the future

#### **Examples:**

- Saved Bookmarks
- Bookmark backup




# **Exporting**

To export and save your Internet Explorer bookmarks, open Internet Explorer

- Click File
- Select "Import and Export"





Choose "Export to a file"

Click Next

Make your selections

• Favorites is all you really need to choose


Click Next




Choose the folders you wish to export - typically "Favorites"

Click Next





Click Browse to choose which folder to save your favorites



Choose your folder
- i.e., "Saved Bookmarks"

Name your file
-i.e., Internet Explorer
bookmark.htm

Click Save

If you use more than one browser, save your bookmarks with an easily recognizable name.


#### For example:


Internet Explorer -- Internet Explorer bookmark.htm

Click Export to save your bookmarks

## **Importing**

To import your saved your Internet Explorer bookmarks, open Internet Explorer

- Select "Import and Export"





Select "Import from a file"

Click Next

Choose the folders you wish to import - typically "Favorites"
