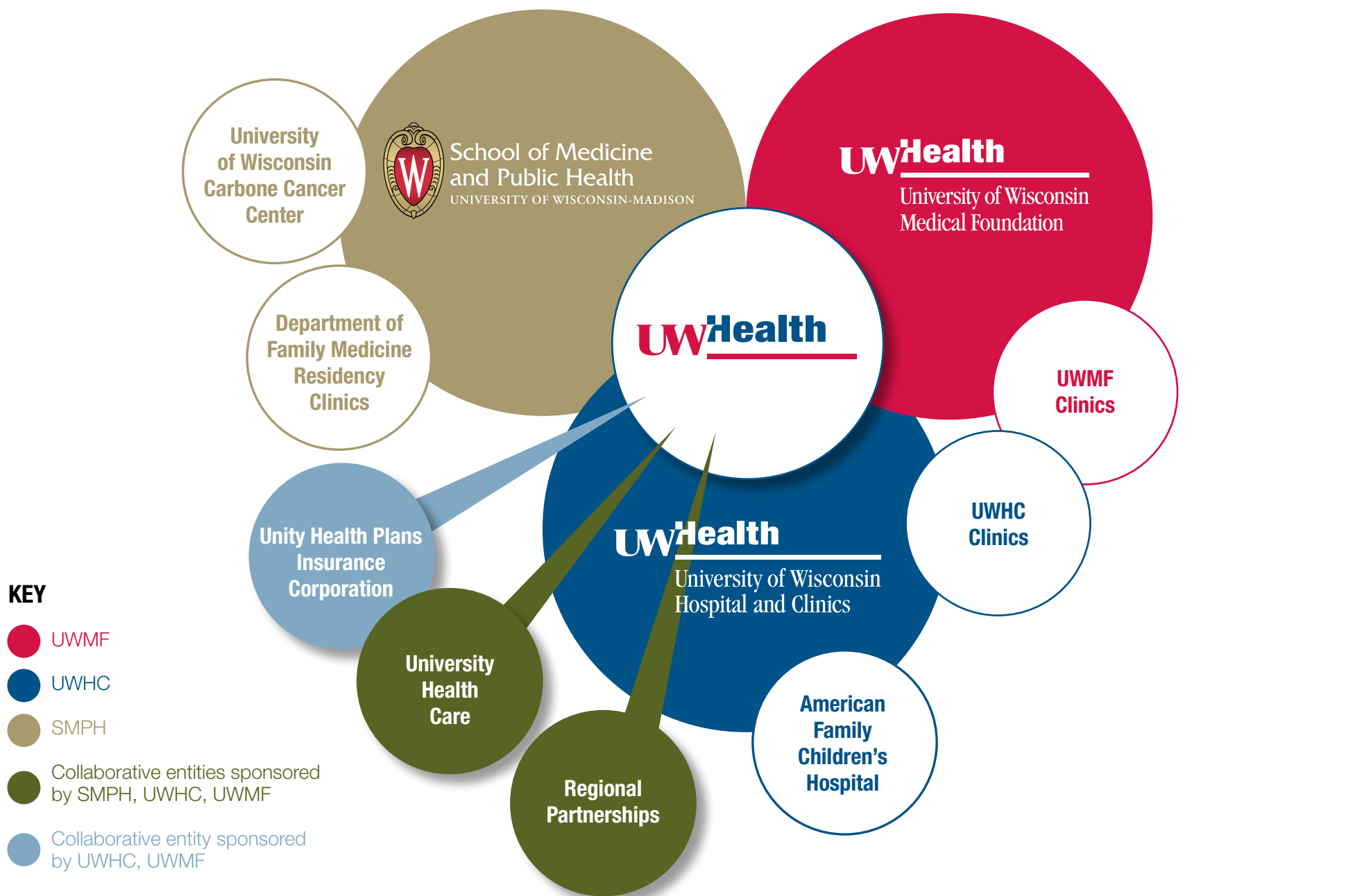

UW HEALTH

UW Health is an academic health system which includes:

- University of Wisconsin Hospital and Clinics (UWHC)
- University of Wisconsin Medical Foundation (UWMF)
- University of Wisconsin School of Medicine and Public Health (UWSMPH)

The UW Health mission is advancing health without compromise through service, scholarship, science and social responsibility.

UW HOSPITAL AND CLINICS

- 566-bed tertiary care facility with one of the nation's largest transplant programs
- Self-supporting; operated as a public authority since 1996
- An ACS-verified Level One trauma facility for both pediatric and adult patients, with Med Flight helicopters and an ACS-verified burn center
- Approximately 7,400 full- and part-time employees at 13 clinical and nonclinical locations;
- Ranked among America's Best Hospitals and #1 hospital in Wisconsin by *U.S. News and World Report*
- Designated a Magnet® Hospital for nursing excellence by the American Nurses Credentialing Center (ANCC)
- Named among the top 10 "100 Best Companies" in the nation by *Working Mother* magazine
- Recognized by Health Information Management Systems Society for Stage 7 implementation of electronic health record
- Named a Comprehensive Stroke Center by The Joint Commission and American Heart Association
- Recognized as one of the nation's Most Wired and Most Wireless hospitals by *Hospitals and Health Networks* magazine

UWHC Clinics

- More than 117 outpatient specialty clinics at nine locations
- Includes outpatient surgery center and ambulatory procedure center

American Family Children's Hospital

- 61-bed pediatric hospital with more than 30 pediatric specialty outpatient clinics
- Special services include hospital school, child life program, pediatric positive image center and 23-bed state-of-the-art pediatric intensive care unit
- Physician staff are UW School of Medicine and Public Health faculty, representing 35 pediatric subspecialties
- Ranked among nation's top 50 childrens hospitals by *U.S. News & World Report*

UW MEDICAL FOUNDATION

- Nonprofit medical foundation organized for the benefit of UW School of Medicine and Public Health and to act as the practice plan for more than 1,300 faculty physicians and 2,400 non-physician staff
- Largest medical group in Wisconsin and among largest in the nation
- Physicians provide care at UWHC, Meriter, St. Mary's, William S. Middleton Veterans and other Wisconsin hospitals

UWMF Clinics

- Clinical practice locations in Columbia, Dane, Dodge, Jefferson, and Marquette counties
- Includes primary care clinics, multispecialty sites, substance abuse/behavioral health clinic, ambulatory surgery center and cosmetic surgery center

UW SCHOOL OF MEDICINE AND PUBLIC HEALTH

- Approximately 1,300 faculty in 10 basic science and 16 clinical departments that include primary care, specialty and subspecialty areas
- Faculty engage in teaching and/or research and/or clinical activities
- Physician faculty practice at more than 50 locations, including UWHC, Meriter, St. Mary's, William S. Middleton Veterans and other clinical settings statewide
- Supports community health projects across the state, sharing expertise, staff and public health research dollars
- Basic, clinical and population health research is funded by grants from NIH, other federal agencies and industry sponsors
- Comprehensive educational offerings for medical students, residents and fellows as well as PhD, MPH, physician assistant and physical therapy programs and continuing professional development

University of Wisconsin Carbone Cancer Center

- One of 41 National Cancer Institute-designated comprehensive centers nationwide
- Collaborations with community cancer centers across the state and in northern Illinois
- Faculty of more than 280 physicians, physician-scientists and basic researchers across the UW-Madison campus
- Operates CancerConnect
- 200-250 clinical trials ongoing at any given time

Department of Family Medicine

- Residency locations in Madison area, Appleton, Eau Claire, Augusta; residents also serve as staff at several Milwaukee clinics
- Rural training track in Baraboo

- Offers a range of insured products for groups and individuals
